Minutes of the Meeting held on 31 January 2020

Welcome to members of IQAC:

The Coordinator, IQAC welcomed all the members for the 2nd IQAC meeting of new cycle(2019-2020) and briefed about the actions taken and report on the previous meeting. A meeting of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell was held on 31st Jan-2020 at 11:30 AM in Conference Hall of Army Institute of Management & Technology, Greater Noida. The following agenda were discussed in 2nd Cycle of IQAC (Oct-Dec 2019).

Agenda- 1: To approve the minutes of meeting held on 16 Oct 2019

The minutes of the meeting were circulated to all the members. No comments have been received. Minutes are deemed to be approved.

Agenda-2: To review the process of 2nd Cycle of NAAC's Assessment and Accreditation.

The Institute got the NAAC accreditation on June 25, 2015 and the first cycle will be expiring on 24 June 2020. The Institute will apply by submitting IIQA as per NAAC guidelines within 6 months of its expiry i.e by 24th June 2020. NAAC allows 45 days to submit SSR after IIQA approval, so SSR will be submitted in the month of April 2020 which shall include last AY as 2018-29. It will also ensure that all 4 AQARs commencing from AY 2014-15 are submitted before submission of IIQA.

Agenda-3: To discuss the status of Academic activities held during Quarter

- a) **Course Delivery Presentation:** All the faculty Members presented the teaching pedagogy of their respective subjects and shared their teaching plan for the semester. The Course Delivery Plan for the new semester commencing on 06 Jan 2020, was prepared by the Faculty, presented and discussed. The methodology for conducting each subject for MBA and BBA was discussed and finalized and included details of Lecture periods, case studies,

assignments, scheme of marking, OTW etc. In addition, the calendar for 2020 was finalized and uploaded on the AIMT website.
