Twenty-Five Hundred years ago, Sun Tzu wrote The Art of War. This classic military strategy book is based on Chinese warfare and military thought. Since that time, all levels of the military have used the teaching of Sun Tzu. Since then, many have adapted these teachings for use in politics, business, and everyday life. "As circumstances are favorable, one should modify one's plans."

· "All warfare is based on deception. Hence when able to attack we must seem unable. When using our forces we must seem inactive. When we are near we make the enemy believe we are far away. When far away we must make the enemy believe we are near."

· "Appear weak when you are strong, and strong when you are weak."

· "If he is superior in strength, evade him."

· "Attack him where he is unprepared. Appear where you are not expected."

· "The general who loses a battle makes a few calculations beforehand."

· "There is no instance of a country having benefited from prolonged warfare."

· "A wise general makes a point of foraging on the enemy. One cartload of the enemy's provisions is equivalent to twenty of one's own."

· "Supreme excellence consists in breaking the enemy's resistance without fighting."

· "The worst strategy of all is to besiege walled cities."

· "There are five essentials for victory: He will win who knows when to fight and when not to fight. He will win who knows how to handle both superior and inferior forces. He will win whose army is animated by the same spirit throughout all its ranks. He will win who, prepared himself, waits to take the enemy unprepared. He will win who has military capacity and is not interfered with by the sovereign."

· "If you know the enemy and know yourself, you need not fear the result of a hundred battles. If you know yourself, but not the enemy, for every victory gained you will also suffer a defeat. If you know neither the enemy nor yourself, you will succumb in every battle."

· "One may know how to conquer without being able to do it."

· "In war, the victorious strategist only seeks battle after the victory has been won."

· "In battle, there are not more than two methods of attack: the direct and indirect."

· "An army may march great distances without distress if it marches through a country where the enemy is not."

· "You can be sure of succeeding in your attacks if you only attack places which are undefended."

· "Military tactics are like water. For water, in its natural course, runs away from high places and hastens downwards. So, in war, the way is to avoid what is strong and strike at what is weak."

· "Let your plans be dark and impenetrable at night, and when you move fall like a thunderbolt."

· "Ponder and deliberate before you make a move."

· "Make your way by unexpected routes and attack unguarded spots."

· "If they will face death, there is nothing they will not achieve."

· "The principle on which to manage an army is to set up one standard of courage which all must reach."

· "If it is to your advantage, make a forward move. If not, stay where you are."

The Art of War is short, concise, and filled with useful advice. Most of the book is clear and easy to understand. The work is so pithy that some of its phrases may seem esoteric or enigmatic. Certain paragraphs make reference to historical events largely unknown in the West; others use words in unusual ways that beg to be clarified. Scholars have analyzed the book thoroughly and explained virtually all its passages, especially the ones that might confuse the modern reader. This guide reflects those understandings.

Events

5th International Conference on Entrepreneurship and Intellectual Property Rights

Inaugural Session

He spoke about startups in India and how they have expanded in the last two decades because of enormous advances in locating resources for financing and capital, which has encouraged an increasing number of people to establish their businesses. Maj Gen Alok Kacker, COS Delhi Area and; Chairman-AIMT began his address by describing how entrepreneurship grew after India adopted liberalization policy in 1990 when our country began to promote companies and, in the recent decade, policymakers in India have focused their attention on encouraging entrepreneurship.

Shri Gajendra Singh Shekhawat, Hon'ble Minister of Jal Shakti-Govt of India talked about Atma Nirbhar Bharat, where the Prime Minister announced Rs. 20 lakh crore economic package under the 'Atma Nirbhar Bharat Abhiyaan', to aid our country off the Coronavirus crisis (by making us self-reliant). Mr. Atul Behari Bhatnagar, Director, Board Member-SunMoksha highlighted the difference between an entrepreneur and a businessman, where he talked about unicorns, and shared his experience on how to build a business. H E Reuben Gauci, High Commissioner-Republic of Malta said that we should be grateful to entrepreneurs who are creating jobs, not for ourselves but also for others. Dr. S P Mishra, Former Director-NIESBUD highlighted how new companies in rural areas have local problems due to a rise in unemployment and found a suitable solution for the same. Mr. Vadim Kotelnikov, Founder and; Global Coordinator of Innompic Games, Innoball, and Business e-Coach, Consultant-United States talked about The Tree of Entrepreneurial Success and the 3C's of an Entrepreneur. Ms. Gunjan Paharia, Managing Partner- Zeus IP discussed the importance of trademarks for goods and services, and provided some examples, also gave a brief about the importance of patents, having an original industrial design, and copyright. The session concluded with a vote of thanks from Col. Rajendra Pandey, Registrar-AIMT.

Track 1, track 2 and track 3 had research paper presentations focusing on Entrepreneurship, Intellectual property Rights and Emerging Trends in Entrepreneurship and IPRs respectively. Mahajan, Executive Director (Academic Publication) Management & Social Science Kalinga Institute of Industrial Technology University ,Dr. Sharadindu Pandey, Assistant Professor Indian Institute of Forest Management, Bhopal .

Name of the college newsletter with the first print and awarded Mr. Manvendra Singh Bhadouria with a trophy for contributing a new identity to the Institute newsletter.



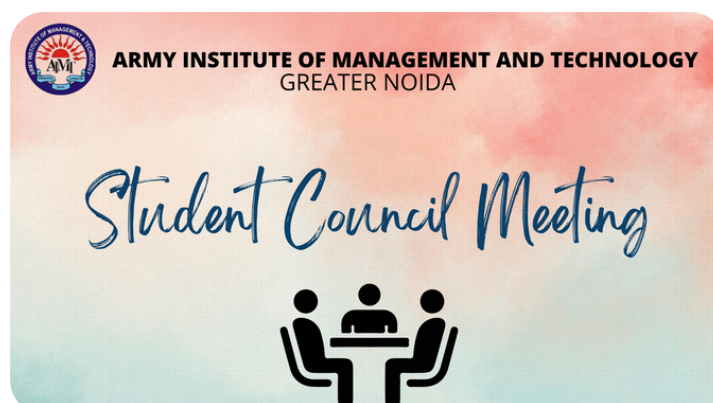
TRADE-A-THON Winner

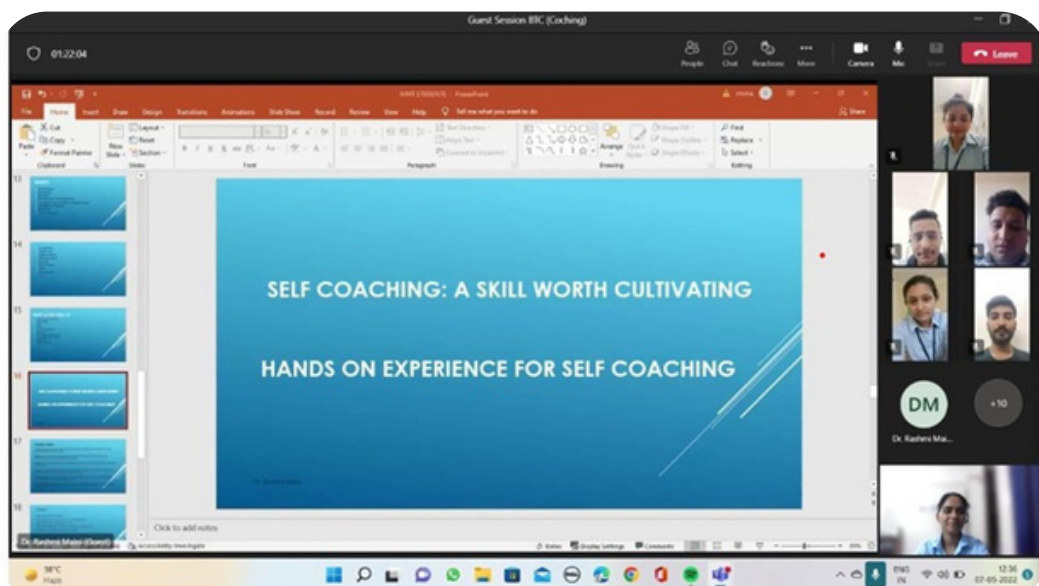


Guest Session on Coaching for Self Development

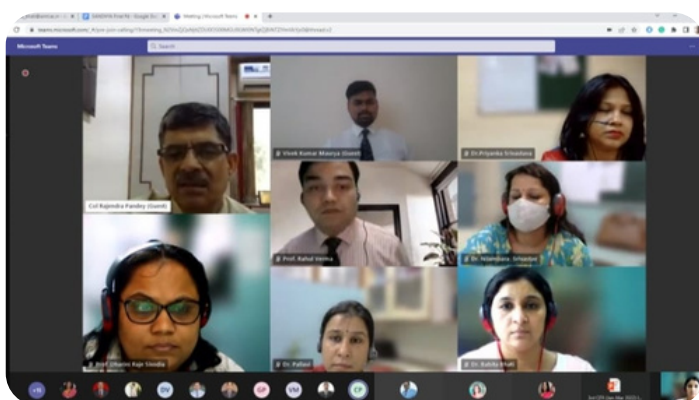
In the end, the vote of thanks was given by Dr. Ruchi Verma.

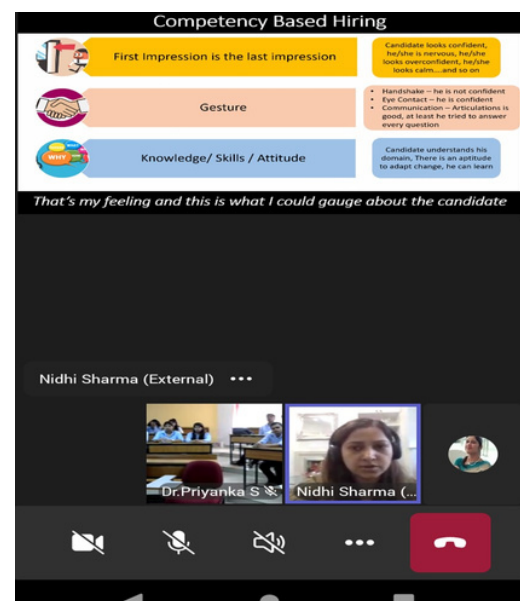
- Personal Awareness

Students actively participated in the session. The speaker then explained how operation management changed during a crisis “Necessity is the mother of invention,” says the adage. 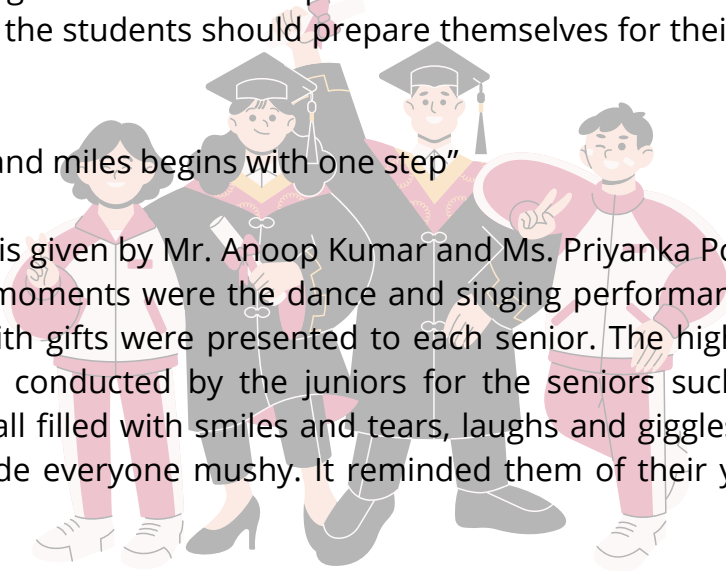
Farewell 2022

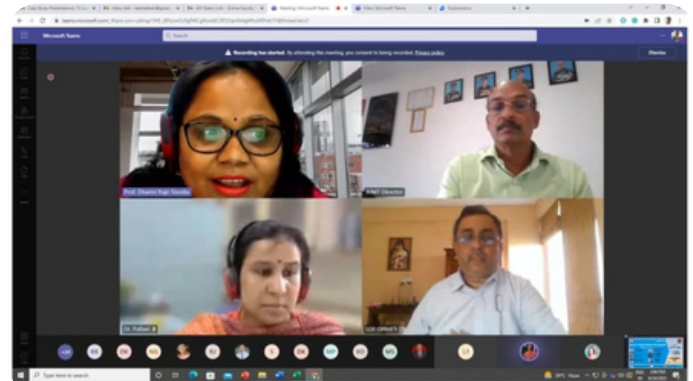

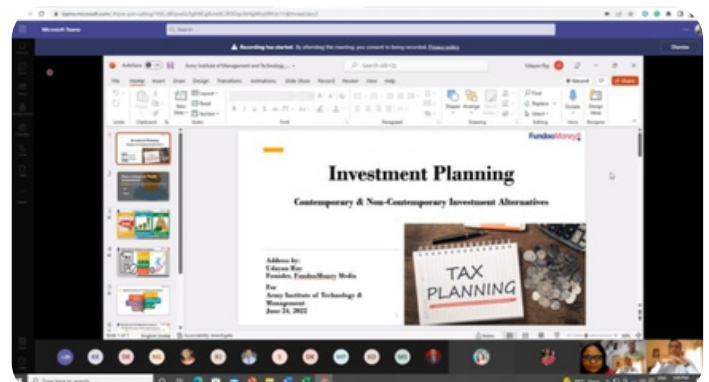

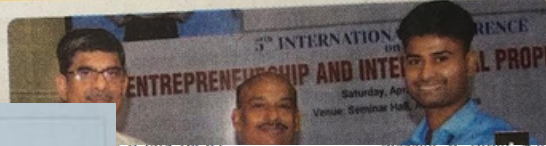
