Sub: Grant of Provisional affiliation for conduct of BCA, and MBA programmes for the academic session 2004-2005.

1. In terms of Section 5 (21) of the Indraprastha Vishwavidyalaya Act 1998, with the prior approval of the Board of Affiliation, I am desirous to convey the approval for Grant of provisional affiliation to **Army Institute of Management & Technology** for conduct of BCA of 3 years duration and MBA of 2 years duration with maximum permitted intake capacity of 50 (fifty only) and 60 (sixty only) seats respectively for the academic session 2004-05. The provisional affiliation is subject to the following conditions: -

- (i) That the society shall adhere to the provisions of the Act, the Statute, the Ordinances and regulations of the Indraprastha Vishwavidyalaya and will comply with the standing order & directions of the University & shall furnish an undertaking to this effect on the format enclosed as Annexure 'A'.
- (ii) That the college shall be required to comply with the (a) General Standards for affiliation of new institutions/ programmes (Appendix-B), (b) General Standards in respect of quality parameters (Appendix - C) and (c) Specific Standards for affiliation of MBA programmes as laid down by the University/AICTE.
- (iii) That the admission for the session 2004-2005 shall be in conformity with the procedure as approved by the University/ State Govt. & college shall not announce admissions directly under any circumstances.
- (iv) That the course curriculum & fee structure will be as prescribed by the University/ State Govt. for the academic session 2004-05.
- (v) That the Institute shall be ready to pay the fee as prescribed below:

(i) Provisional Affiliation fee	Rs. 2,00,000/- for BCA programme
(ii) Provisional Affiliation fee	Rs. 2,00,000/- for MBA programme
(iii) First installment of Endowment fund for <u>BCA</u> programme	Rs. 3,00,000/- in the form of Joint FDR/
- (vi) That the institute shall ensure that permanent qualified and experienced Principal/ Director and Head of the Departments remain in position throughout the academic session 2004-05 for smooth conduct of these programmes and to give the institute a better foundation.

- that the institute will ensure that required qualified senior faculty and other faculty members and staff remain in position dedicated to BCA and MB programmes separately as per the norms of the State Govt./ University/ AICTE for the sanctioned intake during the academic session 2004-05.
- (viii) That the institute will ensure payment of regular salary to the faculty, supporting and administrative staff as prescribed by the Govt./ UGC.
 - (ix) That the institute will not run any unaffiliated course(s) in the same premises where University approved programme(s) is being conducted.
 - (x) That the institute shall keep augmenting the library with latest titles (at least 100 in one semester for each programme), required number of volumes, reference books and subscribe at least 10 national and international journals (for each programme), magazines, newspapers relevant to the course curriculum in order to meet the requirement of sanctioned number of students.
 - (xi) That the institute shall ensure that photocopier facility is provided exclusively for students/ faculty of this programme. A librarian should also be recruited for managing the functioning of the library and maintenance of discipline/ congenial atmosphere for reading.
 - (xii) That the institute shall keep upgrading the configuration of terminals and peripherals with the changing demand, add more licensed software and provide Internet connectivity for working hours to make its students and teachers adequately conversant in the relevant field.
 - (xiii) That the institute shall maintain well-furnished classrooms with necessary instructional aids, adequately equipped labs, computer center with adequate facilities throughout the conduct of these programme(s).
 - (xiv) That the institute shall organize faculty development programmes and student awareness programmes through seminars/ workshops/ conferences for continuing education focused on technical and professional education. The faculty should be motivated for pursuing research and publication of papers in journals of national and international repute.
 - (xv) To ensure maintenance of educational values and quality, the management of the institute should make available a separate budgetary allowance in order to promote excellence and to emerge as an exemplary institution in its own orbit.

2. The compliance report for aforesaid conditions and stipulations of All India Council for Technical Education/ State Govt. should be made available to the University within one week from the date of issuance of this letter.

3. In the event of infringement/ contravention or non-compliance of any of the conditions, guidelines, norms and regulations prescribed by the University/ State Govt. from time to time, the University shall be free to withdraw affiliation and take further
