Workshop on Entrepreneurial Awareness amongst Youth by Mr. Vijay Kumar

In developing training, coaching and mentoring for youth entrepreneurs it is important to develop approaches against the current context of youth in the economy and society. In training programmes there should be a focus on developing entrepreneurial mind-sets, which means changing attitudes. The knowledge required to be an entrepreneur is not only related to professional practice in running a business, but also to skills and attitudes, and to meta- qualities (for example to reflect on self-knowledge). Approaches to learning in small firms have varied over time, and these need to be taken into account. Methods of training need to be varied and can range between traditional ways of informational transfer through to interaction with peers. Formal approaches may be complemented by tacit learning with peers and networks. Monitoring and evaluation is important to increase the effectiveness of programmes. Entrepreneurial networks are important in supporting entrepreneurship as sources of motivation, ideas, information, advice, business partners, employees, and customers. Financial support for youth entrepreneurs also needs to be segmented.

Visit to NSIC, Okhla Delhi – Entrepreneur Orientation Program

NSIC Technical Services Centre, Okhla, New Delhi is one of the Technical Services Centre of National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC), an ISO 9001:2008 certified Government of India Enterprise. NSIC has been working to fulfill its mission of promoting, aiding & fostering the growth of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises. The Technical Services Centre in Okhla, New Delhi is engaged in providing services to MSME units by providing skilled & professional workforce by imparting training on demand driven, industry oriented courses in the fields like Mechanical Workshop, Information Technology, CAD/CAM & CNC, Multimedia & Animation, Electrical & Electronics, Entrepreneurship Development. The curriculum of each training programme is defined in such a way so as to give maximum practical exposure through practical training to the trainees. More than 40,000 trainees are trained by the Centre and successfully placed in companies like Munjal Showa, Motherson Sumi, Mitsubishi Electric Co., HCL Infosys Ltd. and many more, through campus placement.

The Problem of unemployment is becoming a colossal in all of the developing nations. There is enormous increase in the population. Every year India adds to her population afresh. More than this every year about 5 million people become eligible for securing jobs. The remedial measures for reducing unemployment are to lay greater emphasis on creation of opportunities for self-employment, augmentation of productivity and income levels of the working poor, shift in emphasis from creation of relief type of employment to the building up of durable productive assets in the country. In order to inculcate a desire to become entrepreneur among the students NSIC has devised a unique "Entrepreneurship Orientation Programme" (EOP). The program is specially designed for the students, who are still pursuing their studies in Schools/Colleges/Institutions and do not have any idea about Entrepreneurship. Purpose of EOP is to create awareness among the students for setting up of new Enterprise after completion of their studies instead of searching for jobs only. This program makes participants familiar about role and importance of MSMEs in Indian Economy, process of setting up of Enterprise, preparing Project Reports, Identifying marketing possibilities as well as with the issues regarding various statutory requirements such as Income Tax, VAT etc.

MBA 14 Batch has visited the organization to learn more about MSME businesses and what are the required formalities to clear off in order to start. It included all the equipment list and adequate training to be taken before starting out.

Student Exchange Program 2017

This year the students of AIMT, Noida were invited to AIMK campus under student exchange program from 10th - 14th October 2017. Eleven students from AIMT (5 boys and 6 girls) visited AIMK for 5 days. The program consisted of a unique exposure to academics and industry. A number of special academic sessions were conducted during the program. Eminent guest speakers from the industry also delivered industry oriented lectures. Students had visited GRSE for experiencing the real life scenario in the industry. The students also participated in various management games & workshop organised by in-house faculty members.


HINDI PAKHWARA (11th – 25th September)
