A report on Vishleshan 2022 (Post Budget Panel Discussion) on Union Budget-2022

The aspiration to grasp the practical understanding and decoding the innovative provisions of the Indian Union Budget-2022, The Army Institute of Management & Technology organised Vishleshan 2022 (Post Budget Panel Discussion) on Union Budget-2022 on 11th February 2022 at 03.00 pm onwards.

The session started with warm welcome and Saraswati Poojan along with the brief introduction of the panel members. The Director –AIMT welcome the panel members with brief enlight on the policy making and practical understanding on Union budget 2022.

The panel discussion 1 started focusing on the Government Policy framework having significant impact on Trade, Industry and Economy. The panel member **Ms. Manisha Sharma (Assistant Professor, MIMT & Corporate Trainer – Max life Insurance** decoded the provisions and analysed digital economy and digital India regarding unified Logistics Interface and Integration of network facility under PM GATISHAKTI mission, Digitally Agriculture & food processing, MSME, Health, where the focus was to develop online platforms, accessibility of data, E-Shram, Udyan to be interlinked, Education where the focus was to develop more E-content.

Another Panellist **CA Jitnesh Jain- Finance Professionals (Partner JJSK & Associates)** overviewed the Productivity Enhancement & Financing of Investment, he also analysed the tax provisions relating to the digital currency and crypto currency.

The panel discussion 2 started focusing on Tax Implications for the fiscal year 2022-23 where the panel member **Mr. Sunil Kumar Dhareshwar (Senior Vice- President, Finance-Infosys Ltd.)** analysed the taxation aspects relating to different products and services. He also justified the corporate level expectation, reduction in tax rates, surcharge provisions, extension of tax holidays for start ups, ease of administrative performance, reducing litigation etc.

The second panel member **Mr. Manohar Puranik (Financial Education Counsellor- ICICI Foundation for Inclusive Growth)** compared that personal tax not much affected rather corporate level taxes like tax reduced for manufacturing sectors, surcharge rate reduced from 15% to 7%. In response to students query he answered that tax rates on crypto currency i.e. 30% is reasonable. It is an asset, however legal form is debatable.

The another panel member **Mr. Udayan Ray (Founder of Fundoo Money)** compared the personal finances with the corporate finance and its benefits. He explained the practical road map of PM GATISHAKTI for connecting rural economy, different unorganised sectors like Dhaba, Highways and local vendors.

The session was concluded with concluding remarks by Prof. Sandeep Kumar Sahu, then Ms. Arshiya Ismail gave vote of thanks to the entire panellist, coordinators (Prof. Dharini Sisodia, Prof. Sandeep K Sahu and none the less MBA students).
