The event's primary motive was to spread awareness among children about the harmful effects of plastic, & ways to reduce it, as plastic pollution is still rising and destroying Mother Earth. Children being the future of society need to be sensitized to the harmful effects of plastic. Through songs and an 8- minute skit, the members of ISR sent the message that protecting the earth from the hazards of polythene is in the hands of youth.
